Pharmacy Compact 2017

- 6CPA cost effectiveness commitment
- CPA pharmacy programs redesigned under Pharmacy Compact to support the enhanced collection of data
- Data collection commenced:
 - 1 July 2017 for Staged Supply
 - 1 February 2018 for DAA & MedsCheck
- Evaluation being undertaken by HealthConsult

Dose Administration Aids

2017-2018 uptake figures (Feb – Jun 2018)

- Dose Administration Aids services provided to **301,311** unique patients
- Dose Administration Aids services provided by **4,774** community pharmacies
- Evaluation data collected for **25,938** unique patients across **1,207** community pharmacies

Staged Supply

2017-2018 uptake figures

- Staged Supply services provided to **13,483** unique patients
- Staged Supply services provided by **3,204** community pharmacies
- Evaluation data collected for **6,364** unique patients across **2,155** community pharmacies

MedsCheck and Diabetes MedsCheck

2017-2018 uptake figures

- MedsCheck services provided to **299,530** unique patients across **3,887** community pharmacies
- Diabetes MedsCheck services provided to **75,087** unique patients by **2,945** community pharmacies
- Evaluation data collected for **40,179** unique patients across **1,356** community pharmacies
