### STAGE 1 and 2 PBS PROCESS IMPROVEMENTS

## 2023-24 Metrics Report

Clause 6.1 of the 2022-2027 <u>Strategic Agreement</u> between the Commonwealth and Medicines Australia includes a continued focus on HTA process improvements to facilitate earlier patient access to medicines. The metrics in this report have been co-designed and jointly agreed by the parties, in alignment with the main objectives of the Strategic Agreement. They are based on aggregated and de-identified data.

The metrics below cover Stage 1 and Stage 2 PBS process improvements for the period 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2024. This is the fifth report on Stage 1 PBS process improvements, which were implemented on 1 July 2019. This is the third report for Stage 2 PBS process improvements, which were implemented on 1 January 2021.

### STAGE 1 PBS PROCESS IMPROVEMENTS:

## **Pre-Submission Meetings**

- **48** initial pre-submission meetings were requested; **7** withdrawn; **45** accepted; **2** not accepted and **39** meetings have been held.
- 2 subsequent pre-submission meetings were requested; 1 withdrawn; 2 accepted; 0 not accepted and 1 meeting has been held.

## **Notice of Intent**

- **171** *Notice of Intent* forms were received.
- 145 submissions were received.

## **Notice of Intent for Pricing**

- **34.0**% of applicants with a *recommended* outcome lodged their notice of intent for pricing form by week 4 post the PBAC meeting (the earliest opportunity).
- Of these applicants, **69.0%** submitted their pricing offer package in week 5 post the PBAC meeting (the earliest opportunity).

# **Pricing Pathways**

- **18.8%** of pricing offer packages were complete when initially provided to the Department.
- **39.0%** of utilisation and cost model templates were initially provided to the Department in the correct format.
- For applicants who lodged their *notice of intent for pricing* form in week 4 and their pricing offer package in week 5, the time from PBAC minutes to PBS listing date was an average (mean) of **130.1 days** (approx. **4.3 months**) and a median of **130.0 days** (approx. **4.3 months**). This represents **15** out of **52**<sup>1</sup> listings.
- For all other applicants, the time from PBAC minutes to PBS listing date was an average (mean) of **160.3 days** (approx. **5.3 months**) and a median of **159.0 days** (approx. **5.2 months**). This represents **37** out of **52**<sup>1</sup> listings.
- The time from the Department confirming the pricing offer package was lodged correctly to the department and the applicant reaching in principle pricing agreement was an average (mean) of **16 days** and a median of **9 days**.

## **STAGE 2 PBS PROCESS IMPROVEMENTS:**

### **Initial submissions**

- 67.3% of initial submissions were recommended first time (68 out of 101).
- **32.4%** of submissions seeking a higher price over the existing alternative(s) were recommended first time (**12** out of **37**).
- The number of days from PBAC minutes to PBS listing for submissions seeking a higher price over the existing alternative(s) recommended first time was an average of **164.7 days**.
- **0%** of submissions seeking a higher price over the existing alternative(s) submitted their notice of intent for pricing form at the earliest opportunity in week 4 and their pricing offer package in week 5 (**0** out of **13**)<sup>2</sup>.
- 84.5% of cost minimisation submissions were recommended first time (49 out of 58).
- The number of days from PBAC minutes to PBS listing for cost minimisation submissions recommended first time was an average of **157.4 days** and a median of **160 days**.
- **6 submissions** returned to PBAC to seek a review of the positive recommendation.

### Resubmissions

- 97.4% (37 out of 38) of all resubmissions were received as per the PBAC nominated pathway, as advised in the *Notice of Intent* form (1 application was withdrawn, totaling 38 resubmissions).
- 1 resubmission through the Standard Re-entry Pathway was received that did not accept the PBAC nominated pathway.
  - The single resubmission through the Standard Re-entry Pathway was initially a Category 1 submission.
- 13 resubmissions through the Early Re-entry Pathway were received:
  - o **84.6**% were recommended
  - o **53.8**% were initially Category 1 submissions (7 out of 13)
  - o **38.5**% were initially Category 2 submissions (5 out of 13)
  - o 7.7% were initially Major submissions (1 out of 13)
- 3 resubmissions through the Early Resolution Pathway were received:
  - o **66.7**% were recommended
  - o **100.0**% were initially Category 1 submissions (3 out of 3)
- 1 Facilitated Resolution Pathway submission was submitted; the facilitated resolution workshop was held and the submission was recommended by the PBAC at the following meeting.
